LANDSCAPE AWARDS PROGRAM

* The Delaware Nursery & Landscape Association presents its Landscape Awards Program. The program has been revamped in an attempt to address its continued growth and diverse entries, and to recognize the outstanding landscape jobs done by its members.

* The Delaware Nursery & Landscape Association will allocate \$1,000 to the landscape awards program. Winners will receive a monetary award and a recognition plaque for their achievement. Categories will be determined based on entries submitted.

* Residential, commercial and institutional landscapes, hardscapes, and ponds are eligible, and will be grouped in accordance with the job style. The job must have been completed within the past 24 months.

* Only projects that have not been previously submitted are eligible (new phases of previously submitted projects are eligible).

* Presentation of the awards will be made at the Delaware Horticulture Industry Expo in January. Press will be invited to attend awards.

* Winning entries will be posted on the DNLA website.

* All landscapes will be judged by committee. Judging will be based on overall design and installation: how well the landscape suits the site; use of structures and paving; use and selection of plant materials; and maintenance, including neatness, proper pruning, and health of plants. Because of category flexibility, a clear design intent is important.

* In order to be eligible, the landscape:

- must be designed and installed by a current DNLA member

- must have been completed in the past 24 months

- must not have been previously submitted (new phases of previously submitted projects are eligible).

* Applications must be submitted by September 28. Judging will take place by the first week of October. You will be notified of the time that your landscape will be judged.
